11 Anterograde Amnesia The hallmark of the amnesic syndrome is a profound defect in new learning called anterograde amnesia The deficit involves "recent" or "long-term" memory; the essential feature of the deficit is that that patient is impaired in the conscious, deliberate recall of information initially learned after illness onset

High-altitude global amnesia
