India would be about 1,823 million by 2051 and about 300 million tons per annum of MSW will be generated that will require around 1,450 km<sup>2</sup> of land to dispose it in a systematic manner, if ULBs in India continue to rely on landfill route for MSW management (Position paper on the solid waste management sector in India, 2009)
