G1781 Basics of Feeding Horses: Feeding Management

Avoid feeding hay, or any feed, directly on the ground This practice encourages feed waste and increases the risk of parasitic infection Round bales can be a simple and economical method in feeding pastured horses, especially in winter While metal, round-bale feeders can minimize waste, they are also potentially dangerous for horses Figure 1

Best Practice Guidelines for Administering Tube Feeding

- Routinely flush feeding tube with water, preferably sterile water
- Elevate the head of the bed to a 30 - 45 degree angle during enteral feeding and for 30-60 minutes after completion
- Turn off enteral feeding 1 hour before the individual needs to be repositioned at less than 30 degrees
- Clean skin around the feeding tube stoma daily
