Interval scale data has order and a set interval • Celsius (and Fahrenheit) temperatures • Anno Domini years (1990, 1991, 1992, etc) **But ratios of this kind of data are not meaningful • 100°C is not twice as hot as 50°C because 0°C does not indicate a complete absence of heat
