Anecdotal Records (Observations)

However, observation records usually have to be written later at the end of the day Keeping brief notes on index cards or sticky notes carried in your pockets can be helpful Jotting one-word reminders or short phrases on the cards about the event can provide a set of reminders when the observation is written Characteristics of Observation

Aims of the film and its use Pretend play, sometimes also referred to as fantasy, symbolic or role play, is generally seen as being especially important for the development of children's thinking

Anecdotal Observation Resource An end: We call this INFERENCE, SUMMARY, CONCLUSION or COMMENTS This section includes personal and professional interpretations, beliefs and judgments based on the data These comments are reflective of the specific information in the data section There are cases in which "An end" is not needed For instance

TEACHER PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

(a) For the first formal observation during Year 3 of the cycle, the teacher and observer must agree at least five days in advance on the date, time, and place of the observation The teacher must also complete the pre-observation planning document and provide it to the observer no later than three days prior to the scheduled observation

Pre-Observation Form 3 Administrators use this form to interview a teacher prior to observation, helping put the teacher and observing administrator "on the same page" during the observation Post-Observation Form 5 Administrators use this form to guide a post-observation reflection with the teacher
