Historical and projected oil palm plantation area in Indonesia Palm oil is produced from a tropical palm, *Elaeis guineensis*, which is native to West and Central Africa It grows in tropical rainforests with high annual rainfall and temperatures in the range of 24-30° C (Sheil et al, 2009) Oil palm is cultivated on a range of soil
