exclusion increases poverty by reducing groups' access to vital services such as health, education and social protection, and to livelihood opportunities At the same time, poverty increases social exclusion, when access costs to services mean that households cannot afford education and healthcare

Tackling child poverty and social exclusion in the EU

However, child poverty still remains a challenge across many EU countries As of 2016, 26.4 % of children in the EU were at risk of or experiencing poverty or social exclusion, ranging from 13.8 % of young people aged 17 years or younger in Denmark, to 49.2 % of the same age group in Romania⁵
