afghan stitch or single crochet each square on the graph represents 1 stitch for single crochet read the chart from right to left, and then left to right if using afghan stitch always read from the right to start: chain one more stitch than graph estimated yarn needed: black : 3 ounces

white/background:32 ounces red: small amt cafe latte

How to Crochet

crochet, use large pins instead – these • will be much easier to find later Darning needle – to sew your crochet item together It is best to use a blunt-pointed needle with an eye large enough to easily thread the yarn through – like those designed for sewing up knitting and for tapestry and cross stitch The

crochet the seed stitch The seed stitch is an alternating single and double crochet stitch It gives a closed stitch, which resembles a knitted seed stitch
1 Start with a chain Turn, single crochet in the 2nd stitch from the hook
2 Double crochet in the next stitch
3 Single crochet in the next stitch
4 Repeat steps 2 and 3 across the

How to Tie Off Thread After you have completed a stitch you will need to tie a knot to secure the stitch form coming out/unraveling Directions: On your last stitch pull thread to wrong side of fabric Grab a small area of the fabric with the needle and stick the needle through half way Place finger on needle and wrap thread around it 3-4 times (Similar to tying a knot when fishing)

Chain stitch is also known as tambour stitch and point de chainette Chain stitch is one of the oldest of the decorative stitches and is the basis of a

Knit the next stitch and cast the second stitch over it, etc Be careful to cast off loosely, so that the end of the shawl does not pull tightly together To add the fringe, decide which side you consider "the back side" Using a crochet hook, take a piece of fringe, fold it in half, put the crochet hook through a stitch at the bottom of the shawl
