of American education is its decentralization Schools in the United States have been, and remain, overwhelmingly a state and local responsibility Unlike most other nations, the United States does not operate a national education system — with only a few exceptions, notably the nation's military academies and Native American schools

GUIDE TO THE EDUCATION SYSTEM IN THE UNITED STATES

The American education system is unlike that in many other countries Though the US Federal government contributes almost 10% to the national education budget, education is primarily the responsibility of state and local government For example, in Minnesota, almost 80 percent of public education funds come from state sources
